CHADDS FORD TOWNSHIP  
3/10/2008 MEETING

The Board met early to review the proposed signage portion of the new HARB pamphlet. The following wording was approved:

The purpose of the signage ordinance is to encourage compatibility and to provide a visual connection with the building and with the Chadds Ford historic districts. During the design process the applicant should select the sign's size, shape, material, color, graphics (and lighting as outlined in the zoning ordinance) to complement the building's character, and to convey the applicant's business message.

What might be appropriate in one location may not be appropriate in another.

The formal meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Sharp at 7:40 pm. Cynthia Tobias, Kathy Wandersee, Rich Jensen, Kathy Koch, Sundari Balakrishnan, and Alison Lee attended.

Minutes of the 2/11/2008 meeting were approved as read.

An application for Certificate of Appropriateness for proposed signage for the old WAWA space was on the agenda, but the applicant, Kevin Cattie, did not appear. The application did not provide specifications on materials, colors, and lighting, etc.

A motion was passed to deny the application due to lack of information regarding materials and lighting.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:25 pm. The next board meeting is scheduled for April 14.
