11/10/2008 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm by Chairman Gary Sharp. Board members Kathy Wandersee, Sundari Balakrishnan, Cindy Tobias, Rich Jensen, and Alison Lee attended.

Minutes of the 9/8/2008 meeting were approved as read and will be available for posting on the township web site.

Jeff Bowden, roofing contractor, appeared before the Board on behalf of Wayne Grafton with an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness to replace the roof on the building known as the old post office. The current roof is cedar shakes and is leaking.

He provided examples of Lamarite Shakes by Tamko, which mimic cedar shakes and are fire-resistant.

During a short discussion, Kathy Wandersee provided a brief history of the building, which was originally a barn on the opposite side of Route 1, owned by the Pyle brothers. There is a millstone dated 1781.

The Board did not recommend that a Certificate of Appropriateness be granted, as the roof was not being replaced in kind.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
